A social skills group designed for children ages 3-6 who exhibit difficulties with communication, social/peer interactions, and/or play skills. The group is led by an occupational therapist and therapy technician. The group may help your child:

- develop age appropriate play skills
- improve social interaction with peers
- enhance sensory processing abilities

When: Groups meets Mondays-Thursdays for 1 hour from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. for a 1 week (4 day) session Dec 28th through Dec 31st, 2009.

Who: Ideal for children with Autism Spectrum Disorder, ADD/ADHD, Social Skills Impairment, sensory impairments & Developmental Delays

Cost: \$145.64 (\$36.41 per session)
* Payment can either be made in full prior to the first session, or half prior to the first session and half prior to the fifth session.
*\$50 non-refundable deposit is required 2 weeks prior to the first class
